### **ABOUT US**

The Pig Hunters Association of Oahu (PHAO) was established in 1969. Through the years, the club has developed into a social group where hunters can talk about their experiences, and a club with civic and community duties.



Feral pigs are dangerous and cause serious injuries to humans and livestock. They damage property, crops, native and endangered plants, and contaminate natural water resources.

### **SERVICES**

#### **FERAL PIG CONTROL**

There is an ongoing feral pig problem on Oahu and the club addresses this issue by controlling the feral pig population. The club receives referrals from the State of Hawaii, DLNR, Hawaiian Humane Society, and Honolulu Police Department.

Since its establishment, the **PHAO** has removed feral pigs from golf courses, hospital surroundings, and many other private homes and organizations; including eradication for some of the Bishop Estate properties.

#### **SEARCH AND RESCUE**

In cases of lost hikers, the **PHAO** also offer its services to the Honolulu Fire Department. With our knowledge of mountain areas, the club is available to assist with search and rescue efforts.
